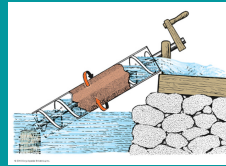

Give more than one reason to support a historical argument.

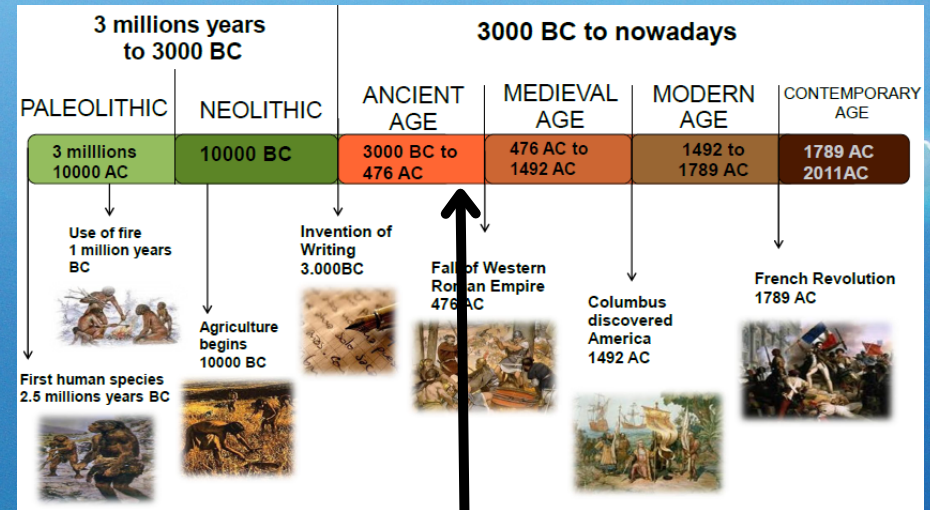
Use artefacts from ancient civilization and say how they may have been used.
